

## **Theater Ensemble Agreement**

## The undersigned agrees to the Yocum Institute for Arts Education, Primary Stages Program:

- 1. To be available and attend all weekly rehearsals unless advance prior arrangements have been made and accepted by the Lead Teacher. Extenuating circumstances that result in an unforeseen absence will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. To be fully prepared for each rehearsal, i.e. lines memorized, dressed in appropriate clothing to move easily, have materials fully accessible.
- 7. To provide a registration form and payment of the annual registration fee (\$40 as of Sept. 2015) within 2 weeks of date of acceptance, and annually as participation continues. \*scholarship funding and payment plans are available; please see Lead Teacher if this is needed.
- 3. To attend, and be on time, for all scheduled rehearsals that may be added to prepare for a specific performance. Except in emergencies, all rehearsal conflicts must be clearly stated a minimum of 2 weeks prior.
- 4. To arrive a minimum of 45 minutes before any show time, unless other prior arrangements have been made with the Stage Manager, Lead Teacher and/ or Director.
- 5. To participate in publicity events and/or provide technical assistance (as agreed upon in advance).
- 6. To provide clothing currently owned by the actor for costume elements if requested to do so by the costume designer. Clothing owned by the actor will be used in a show only with permission.
- 8. To be responsible for your behavior at any location and/or events that are part of Ensemble programming. You are considered an ambassador to the larger community for the Yocum Institute for Arts Education.
- 9. To provide a "Thank you note" to the Scholarship sponsor upon request.

## The Yocum Institute for Arts Education, Primary Stages Program agrees to provide the following:

- 1. Weekly rehearsals that include training in the theater arts will be held at a minimum of 40 weeks of the year.
- 2. For upcoming projects and performances that are part of the Theater Ensemble programming, auditions for specific roles will be held with the Ensemble as the primary casting pool.
- 3. As the Ensemble and/ or specific shows are deemed "prepared" by the lead instructor, performances will be scheduled throughout the community.
- 4. For ensemble performances held at the Yocum Institute for Arts Education, in which admission is charged, the undersigned will receive two personal-comp tickets throughout the run.
- 5. An "Ensemble" T-shirt will be provided at cost to each member for group performances in the community.
- 6. Guest instructors and directors will be introduced and lead specific projects/ classes.
- 7. Offerings on occasion of discounted rates and/ or the opportunity to participate in advanced/ adult level workshops at the Yocum Institute for Arts Education.
